

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## THE VINTAGE

An astonishingly resilient vintage with a truly exceptional quality.

A magnificent vintage that, contrarily to expectations, triumphed over spring frosts, drought and heatwaves to offer superb balance, density and freshness.

This was a year in which the terroir demonstrated its extraordinary capacity for resilience when it is well cared for and the surrounding ecosystem is preserved. While, at the end of August, the gardens and trees were already showing signs of fatigue and losing their leaves due to 2022's four heatwaves and exceptional drought, the vines remained green and in excellent health.

To protect them against such extreme conditions, we have been practising preventive measures for several years, such as late pruning, plant cover and relatively little tillage. The vineyard was managed very carefully during July and August, by spraying calcium and clay, to give the vines relief from the heat, and aeration of the foliage around the bunches, but without thinning the leaves so as keep some protection against the sun.

The harvests, which began on 24 August for the whites, progressed quickly without any problems, and

the last rows of Cabernet Sauvignon were picked on 29 September.

Although early, the vintage nevertheless produced perfectly ripe grapes, which offered superb structure.

The whites display great finesse, airiness and surprising freshness. They are very elegant, the Sauvignons are particularly expressive with an excellent tight structure. The very precise vinification and the gentle barrel-ageing have enabled a bright, lively character to be highlighted.

For the reds, the key to this vintage lies firstly in the exceptional maturity of Malartic's Cabernet grapes. This allowed us to obtain sumptuous wines with superb substance and a silky texture supported by a dense structure. Malartic 2022's tannic balance is thus particularly interesting: With plenty of freshness, the slender Merlot brings volume and softness. The spectacular Petit Verdot, with remarkable fruitiness and creaminess, contributes with the Cabernet Franc to a global freshness and aromatic richness.

Malartic 2022 reveals tremendous harmony and silkiness, accompanied by very elegant, finely textured tannins, worthy the greatest vintages.

This is very, very fine with wonderfully polished tannins that are silky in texture. It's medium-to full-bodied with lovely length, lasting a minute or two. Hints of crushed stone and fine sea salt. Finesse with structure. Could move up a notch with the élevage. 53% cabernet sauvignon, 43% merlot, 2.5% petit verdot, and 1.5% cabernet franc.

Though Château Malartic-Lagravière’s production was limited, the quality is undoubtedly exceptional. Their wines are renowned for their sweetness and vibrance even when young. But in 2022, it builds upon this foundation by incorporating greater depth and intensity, much like a piece of obsidian shrouded in a mysterious glow. It may seem understated, yet very dynamic. If the structure remains balanced after bottling, it has the potential to become one of the most outstanding vintages in its history.

Deep garnet-purple in color, the 2022 Malartic Lagravire Rouge charges out with profound notes of creme de cassis, chocolate-covered cherries, and plum preserves, followed by suggestions of garrigue and unsmoked cigars. The full-bodied palate is taut with dense, muscular black fruits, supported by firm, rounded tannins and just enough freshness, finishing with great length.

**Neal Martin – You’re Unbelievable : Bordeaux 2022 - 05/2023**

The 2022 Malartic-Lagravière was picked 5 to 29 September at 27hL/ha and matured in 60% new oak. Blackberry, iodine and incense aromas unfurl in the glass, nicely focused and delineated, quite airy in style. The palate is medium-bodied with grainy tannins. Cohesive and powdery in texture, with black fruit, crushed stone and light ash-like notes toward the finish. This is an excellent, quite “swarthy”

Malartic that will age with style, though it will only repay the patient.

**Jeb Dunnuck – Bordeaux 2022 En Primeur – 05/2023**

The 2022 Château Malartic-Lagravière does incredibly well in the vintage and offers a beautiful sense of freshness and elegance while still staying concentrated and textured. A blend of 53% Cabernet Sauvignon, 43% Merlot, and the balance Petit Verdot and Cabernet Franc, it has an up-front, expressive style in its red and blue fruits as well as spring flower, tobacco, and graphite-like aromatics. Medium to full-bodied on the palate, it has ripe, polished tannins, fabulous overall balance, and a great finish. The purity and precision here are top-notch.

### Chris Kissack – BORDEAUX 2022 PRIMEURS: PESSAC-LÉOGNAN – 05/2023 93-95

The 2022 from this estate is 53% Cabernet Sauvignon, 43% Merlot, 2.5% Petit Verdot and 1.5% Cabernet Franc, picked at a yield of just 27 hl/ha. A rather open, sweet and expressive nose, with perfumed black cherry, blackberry and currant fruits, with suggestions of dark and sooty tannins. The palate shows real texture, cohesion and harmony, with a velvety wrapping of damson, currant and black bean, touched with sage and slate, around a core of nicely buried tannins. This holds together very well, the structure rich but nicely polished and tight-knit. This is a success for the vintage, for sure. Absolutely delicious, in fact. 93-95/100

### Jane Anson – En Primeur 2022 Left Bank – 05/2023

Deep plum colour, plush damson and black cherry, with a well textured grain to the tannins that stops things being overly sweet. This is a brilliant Malartic-Lagravière, just absolutely hits the spot between excess and restraint, so much detail and concentration to the fruit, and it manages to pull up just short of too much, delivering a cooler blueberry and mint leaf exit that draws things out through the palate and opens things up for a smoky woodfire soot edge. Total class.

### Georgie Hindle - Decanter

Round, concentrated, vibrant and dynamic, a lovely burst of intense red and black fruits before quite serious tannins take hold in the mouth. Fine but full, they give the frame and the structure, setting the tone for a serious wine while the fruit and freshness softly expand giving an aerial element to the finish. A lovely wine with intensity and detail, not the most demonstrative or juicy and appealing right now, but really well made and delivered. Supple, bright, chalky, chewy, this wine has intensity and precision. A little bit serious towards the end, the fruit just losing some focus, where it becomes more about the tannins and freshness but lots to like here with good potential. 1.5% Cabernet Franc. A yield 27hl/ha. HVE3 certified.
