September, though more uncertain, enabled us to ensure a reasonably abundant harvest and to pick some very nice grapes.

Deep purple in colour.

The nose, floral at first, becomes more complex with red fruit and black berry notes.

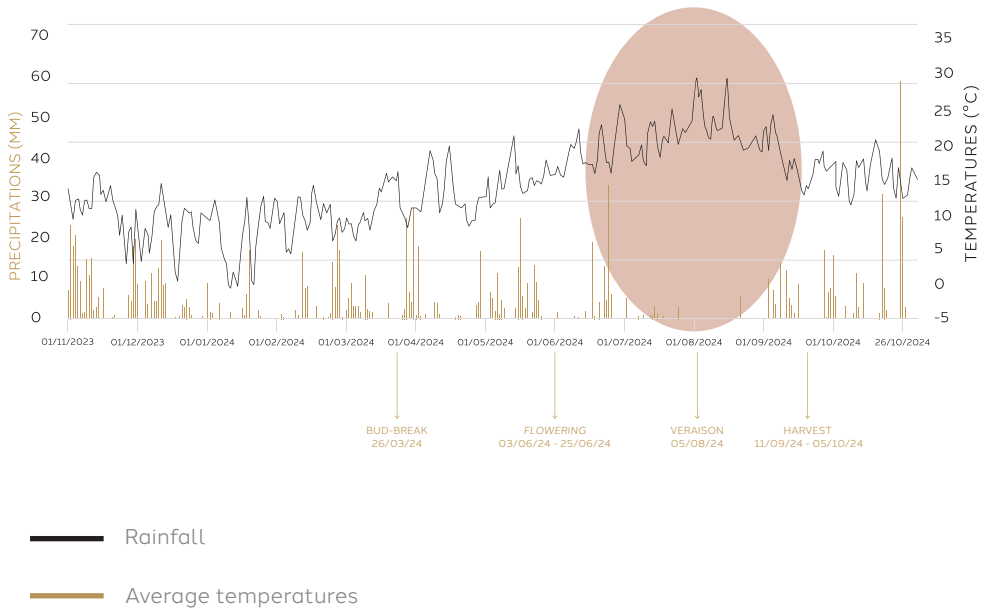
Juicy and flavourful on the palate, this wine shows great length, carried by the perfectly ripe tannins of the Merlot.
