The walk from Saintayme to L'Église Clinet 2023 turns out to be a very subtle one. Merlot carries truffle, blackcurrant and violet nuanced with acacia, medlars and chocolate. Ruby broadcasts both color and flavor...

Marie Reilhac Durantou – Co-gérante

2023 Saintem Saintayme (Saint Émilion Grand Cru)

100% Merlot, picked between the 27th of September and the 04th of October. **67 000 btls. 14,60% vol. New oak: 30%.**

2023 La Chenade (Lalande de Pomerol)

Blend of 100 % Merlot this year, from vines planted on sandy-gravelly soil in Durantou's Lalande de Pomerol estate. Picked on the 13th of September. **8 500 btls. 14,30% vol. New oak: 40%.**

2023 Château Les Cruzelles (Lalande de Pomerol)

Blend of 80 % Merlot and 20% Cabernet Franc from gravel-clayey soil.

The Merlot was picked between the 11th and the 16th of September and the Cabernet Franc on the 16th of September and the 18th of September. **24 800 btls. 14,50% vol. New oak: 55%.**

2023 Château Montlandrie (Castillon Côtes de Bordeaux)

Blend of 55% Merlot, 20% Cabernet Franc and 25% Cabernet Sauvignon.

The Merlot was picked on the 10th then between the 18th and the 23rd of September, the Cabernet Franc on the 20th and 21st of September and the Cabernet Sauvignon on the 30th of September. **41 000 btls. 14,50% vol. New oak: 50%.**

2023 La Petite Église (Pomerol) is a blend of 90% Merlot and 10% Cabernet Franc.

The Merlot was picked between the 9th and the 14th of September, and the Cabernet Franc on the 14th of September. **5 800 btls. 14,40% vol. New oak: 82%.**

2023 Château L'Église Clinet (Pomerol) is a blend of 90% Merlot and 10% Cabernet Franc.

The Merlot and the Cabernet Francs were picked between the 10th and the 14th of September.

Confidential. 14,60% vol. New oak: 82%.
