JAMES SUCKLING - 95 - 96

This is very complex with super fine, silky tannins that just take off. Full bodied with berry, chocolate and walnut flavors. Mushrooms and cedar, too.

YVES BECK - 94 - 95

Rouge grenat dense aux reflets violets. Que de complexité, d'intensité et de fraîcheur dans le bouquet de Bellefont-Belcier. Subtiles notes d'élevage et invitante nuances de baies noires avec des myrtilles, des mûres et du bois de réglisse. En bouche le vin parvient à encore mieux révéler son terroir au travers d'une rafraîchissante tension calcaire. Que de vivacité et d'ampleur. Les tannins sont compacts, aux grains fins et puissants, ce qui est de bon augure face au tempérament croquant et vif de la structure. Finale fruitée et persistante. Un grand vin ! 2024-2043

JEFF LEVE - 94 - 96

With pungent aromas of crushed rock and stone in the forefront, the nose quickly moves to the floral side before the red berries, smoke and licorice kick in. Concentrated, with velvet textured, salty tannins and waves of sweet, ripe, fresh berries, the finish really sticks with you. The wine was made from blending 70% Merlot, 25% Cabernet Franc and 5% Cabernet Sauvignon, reaching 13.95% alcohol. The wine is aged in 40% new French oak barrels with 20% of the wine aging in foudres.

VERT DE VIN - 94 - 95

The nose is elegant and offers concentration, intensity and deepness. It reveals notes of cassis, Boysen berry, small notes of crushed wild raspberry associated with touches of very ripe cherry, liquorice and Sichuan pepper. the palate is fruity, mineral, well-balanced and offers a beautiful suavity, a finesse of the grain and freshness. On the palate this wine expresses notes of fleshy/juicy blackberry, juicy cassis, small notes of raspberry associated with touches of juicy/fresh plum, cherry as well as fine hints of violet, camphor and cocoa. Tannins are precise, racy and fine. Good length.
