THE VINTAGE

An astonishingly resilient vintage with a truly exceptional quality.

A magnificent vintage that, contrarily to expectations, triumphed over spring frosts, drought and heatwaves to offer superb balance, density and freshness.

This was a year in which the terroir demonstrated its extraordinary capacity for **resilience** when it is well cared for and the surrounding ecosystem is preserved. While, at the end of August, the gardens and trees were already showing signs of fatigue and losing their leaves due to 2022's four heatwaves and exceptional drought, the vines remained green and in excellent health.

To protect them against such extreme conditions, we have been practising **preventive measures** for several years, such as late pruning, plant cover and relatively little tillage. The vineyard was managed very carefully during July and August, by spraying calcium and clay, to give the vines relief from the heat, and aeration of the foliage around the bunches, but without thinning the leaves so as keep some protection against the sun.

The harvests, which began on 24 August for the whites, progressed quickly without any problems, and

the last rows of Cabernet Sauvignon were picked on 29 September.

Although early, the vintage nevertheless produced **perfectly ripe grapes**, which offered superb structure.

The whites display great finesse, airiness and surprising freshness. They are very elegant, the Sauvignons are particularly expressive with an excellent tight structure. The very precise vinification and the gentle barrel-ageing have enabled a bright, lively character to be highlighted.

For the reds, the key to this vintage lies firstly in the exceptional maturity of Malartic's Cabernet grapes. This allowed us to obtain sumptuous wines with superb substance and a silky texture supported by a dense structure. Malartic 2022's tannic balance is thus particularly interesting: With plenty of freshness, the slender Merlot brings volume and softness. The spectacular Petit Verdot, with remarkable fruitiness and creaminess, contributes with the Cabernet Franc to a global freshness and aromatic richness.

Malartic 2022 reveals **tremendous harmony** and silkiness, accompanied by very elegant, finely textured tannins, **worthy the greatest vintages**.

PRESS REVIEW

Jeb Dunnuck – Bordeaux 2022 En Primeur – 05/2023 94-97

Up with the crème de la crème, 2022 Château Malartic-Lagravière Blanc is based on 76% Sauvignon Blanc and 24% Sémillon, all of which is still aging in 50% new French oak. It has an incredible bouquet of honeyed citrus, grapefruit, and flowers to go with medium to full-bodied richness and depth on the palate. It's concentrated, has a great texture, nicely integrated acidity, and a brilliant finish. Yields here were a miniscule 18 hectoliters per hectare, and the Grand Vin is a selection of only 44% of the total production.

This is very, very fine with wonderfully polished tannins that are silky in texture. It's mediumto full-bodied with lovely length, lasting a minute or two. Hints of crushed stone and fine sea salt. Finesse with structure. Could move up a notch with the elevage. 53% cabernet sauvignon, 43% merlot, 2.5% petit verdot, and 1.5% cabernet franc.

The wine glass radiates waves of pure aromas, as if you're

scooping up an assortment of fruits from a clear blue swimming pool: papaya, Buddha's hand, grapefruit, green pineapple, beeswax, and tangerines, quickly amassing a sizeable collection. Château Malartic-Lagravière's 2022 white wine boasts a rich and rounded body, steeped in depth and character, concluding with a subtle touch of saltiness. This exquisite balance of sweetness and saltiness sets a unique standard in 2022, marking it as one of the exceptional white wines of the year.

Lisa Perotti Brown – 2022 Primeurs – 05/2023 92-94

The 2022 Malartic Lagraviere Blanc needs a little swirling to unlock notes of Golden Delicious apples, white peaches, and fresh straw, leading to hints of coriander seed and white pepper. The medium-bodied palate coats the mouth with expressive apple and pear flavors, framed by seamless freshness, finishing long and spicy.

Neal Martin – You're Unbelievable : Bordeaux 2022 - 05/2023 91-93

The 2022 Malartic-Lagravière blanc was cropped at 18hL/ ha between 24 August an 1 September, aged in 50% new oak. Pressed dried flowers on the nose, scents of dandelion and yellow plum, a touch of fennel coming through with time. The palate is well balanced with a pithy opening, nutty and smoky in style, good depth with that nutty finish offering noticeable salinity. Very fine

Pale gold, excellent grip, white pear and citrus, luscious lemon and green apple, this is a good walking the line between full exotic fruits and fleshier green apple and sage. Great stuff from this excellent property.

Herbal and aromatic on the nose, expressive and engaging. Full, round and energetic, a lovely frame and texture to this, lovely licks of lemon, grapefruit, pear, apricot, some bitter lemon rind giving accents and a gorgeous



persistence, not so vibrant, but there's underlying acidity that keeps the lift and it's so well controlled and confident. Really feels very precise and delineated, polished and structured, still with some spice giving some tension but this is really lovely. Complete and characterful. A yield of 18hl/ha.

Flowers, white chocolate, pineapple, spice, papaya, white peach, and orange scents are easy to pick up on the nose. On the palate, the wine is fresh, sweet, and fruity leaving you with creamy yellow citrus, grapefruit and white peach notes. The wine blends 76% Sauvignon Blanc with 24% Semillon. The harvest took place August 24 - September 1. 14.56% ABV, pH3.29. Drink from 2025-2032.

Couleur jaune pâle. Nez intense, fin, au fruité mûr et subtil. Nuances de fleurs et de miel. Délicat en entrée de bouche, très minutieux au toucher, avec un corps fondant, le vin évolue séveux et suave en même temps, sur une longue finale caressante. C'est très bon. Unlike the second wine, Le Comte, this has richer and more intense citrus aromas with some waxed lemon and grapefruit zest. There is also the beginning of spices from oak. It has an atypically high level of acidity for the vintage, but this is really in its favour as it complements the depth of creamy citrus fruit flavours. A lovely well textured silky finish completes the picture. Very good.

RVF – Pierre citerne – Primeurs Pessac-Leognan 91-93

Toujours nettement dominé par le sauvignon (76 %) le blanc de Malartic-Lagravière offre un profil d'emblée très aromatique, miellé, floral, suggérant l'acacia et le chèvrefeuille.
